Class proposals are evaluated and selected on the basis of:

- Marketability
- Non-duplication
- Suitability to the College Mission
- Qualification of presenters
- Availability of facilities

Community Education Presenters are either employees or vendors of our District and are paid based on the number of students who attend their classes. The average is 40% of the class income.

- Proposals for Winter (Jan 15 - Mar 31) are due by September 15th
- Proposals for Spring (April 1 - June 14) are due by December 1st
- Proposals for Summer (June 15 - Aug 30) are due by February 1st
- Proposals for Fall (Sept 10 - Dec 15) are due by May 1st
